THE GOOD NEWS FROM LONGTON & DMC

After seven months of bad news for the Sprint and Hillclimb world with event and championship cancellations, we are now in a position to look forward with some positive information.

The Club's committee has been busy looking into the different scenarios that may exist at the start of 2021 and various items will be advised to you through these bulletins over the coming weeks.

We will, of course, have to abide by Government and Motorsport UK regulations should we still be suffering from Covid-19 as a country, but we will have the advantage of experience within our sport generally with time to consider different options available to us.

These items will not just be taking events into account but also the care and support of all our marshals and officials who make the events and championships happen.

The first pieces of good news concerns the finances involved. We have consulted with all our external contractors and agreed their fees to us for the 2021 season. We thank them all for their continued support and as a result of these negotiations the following are now confirmed.

Club Membership

Starting in November, members who have paid for 2020 will have 2021 membership cards sent to them free of charge. These will be valid until the end of 2021. New members joining the Club will be charged at the 2020 rate which is:

Championship Registration Fees

All competitors registered for our 2020 series will automatically have these fees transferred to the 2021 championships. Drivers are entitled to a refund of their 2020 fees should they wish by contacting the Entries Secretary with their request.
